The Windsor Alumni Association awarded 10 scholarships of \$500 each to 2009 graduates. They were selected from 29 applications presented to the Scholarship Committee. All applicants were good candidates for the awards. We wish to thank the counselors, lead by William O'Donnell, for their cooperation in obtaining the applications.

The awards were presented on May 19th at the Awards Night Ceremonies. Since 2000, the Alumni Association has awarded \$52,900.00 in scholarships. These awards were very well received by the graduates. The Scholarship Committee considers a student's marks, class ranking, family sizes, siblings in college, and family situations.

Those applying are asked to complete an application and answer the questions forthrightly for the Committee to make the serious decision regarding who is to receive the awards.

We would like to also note that the Class of 1959 presented the Alumni Association with a check for \$1,959.00 at the Alumni Dinner on 6/26/2009, in support of the Scholarship Fund. J. Gordon Sheehy (Class of 1959) challenged each class, during his presentation, to organize a class donation equivalent to \$1 from each graduate, for every year since they graduated.
